- Nebraska City Unit 1 – Capacity Factor: 61.2%
- Nebraska City Unit 2 – Capacity Factor: 64.6%
- North Omaha Unit 4 – Capacity Factor: 67.7%
- North Omaha Unit 5 – Capacity Factor: 53.6%

October Peaking Generation

- Cass County – Capacity Factor 4.1%
- Jones Street – Capacity Factor 0%
- North Omaha Unit 1 – Capacity Factor 0%
- North Omaha Unit 2 – Capacity Factor 0%
- North Omaha Unit 3 – Capacity Factor 1.9%
- Sarpy County – Capacity Factor 2.4%

October Renewables

- Renewable energy contributed 40.6% of OPPD's retail energy sales.
- Wind capacity factor of 44.8%
- Capacity Factor for Community Solar 17.7%.

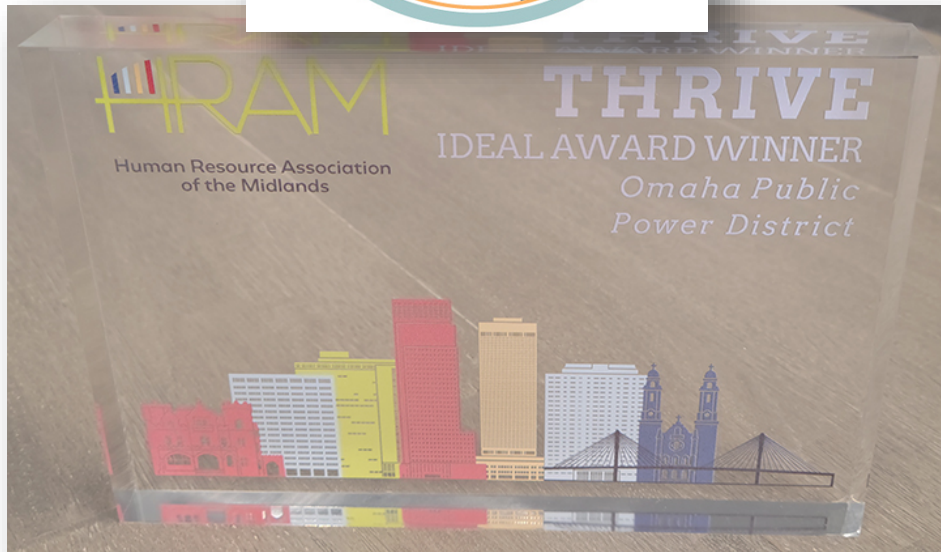

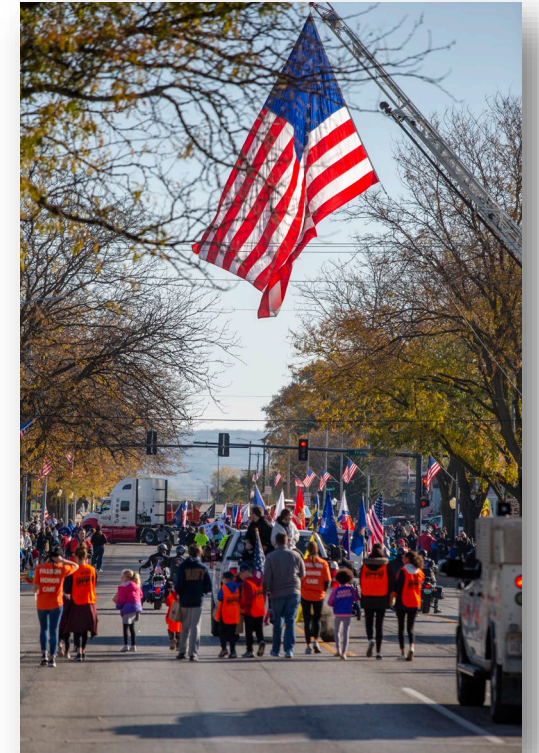
