UNDERGROUND RESIDENTIAL SERVICES (NEW CONSTRUCTION) BUILDER INSTALLED DUCT

Effective **January 1, 2017**, **all** new underground residential electrical services will be required to be installed in conduit. Lot owners or builders will be responsible for providing and installing a service conduit from the OPPD transformer or pedestal stub-out to the meter socket per the attached OPPD Meter Manual Specification 7.02.2. The Specification is included with this notice and can also be found on OPPD.com at www.oppd.com/MeterManual. OPPD will continue to provide the service wire from the meter socket on the dwelling unit to OPPD's nearest point of power supply.
