- ~~• The Board establishes that a long-term goal of at least 30% of retail energy sales shall be supplied from renewable energy sources.~~
- OPPDD shall conduct its business in a manner that, at a minimum, meets all environmental regulatory standards and enhances natural resource conservation and stewardship.
- Demonstrate accountability and transparency by measuring and reporting its environmental performance in support of applicable regulatory standards.
- Pursue a long term goal of 20% reduction in carbon intensity from 2010 through 2030 as measured by the Climate Registry Electric Power Sector Protocol.
- Strive toward a long-term goal of at least 50% of retail energy sales supplied from renewable energy sources.
- Develop and deliver innovative energy products, programs and services that help customers achieve their environmental goals.
- ~~OPPDD shall participate and provide leadership in the development of national, state, and regional environmental policies and initiatives that support OPPD's mission.~~
- Manage internal operations to promote the efficient use of resources and minimize environmental impact.
