

# SARPY TRANSMISSION PROJECT



## PROVIDING THE PATH TO NEW DEVELOPMENT

**Omaha Public Power District takes great pride in meeting the energy needs of today, while planning and preparing for the needs of the future.**

Papillion, Sarpy County, and the entire greater Omaha area are currently experiencing commercial, industrial and residential growth. To support this growth, OPPD will construct a new overhead high-voltage transmission line, known as the Sarpy Transmission Project (STP) in the Papillion area.

The STP plan has been upgraded due to continued economic development interest in the area. Changes include a slight route modification, as well as equipment upgrades.

By taking these steps now, OPPD will be able to accommodate anticipated and planned growth. Upgrades also help ensure electric service reliability in the area.

### Route

- The STP line will extend from north of 114th Street and Cornhusker Road to south of 144th Street and Schram Road. (see map on reverse side)
- Modified route segments will extend STP closer to areas of anticipated and planned load growth.

### Equipment upgrades

- Previously planned 161 Kilovolt (kV) and 69 kV lines will now be upgraded to 345 kV and 161 kV lines.
- The original proposed easement widths will not be impacted by these voltage changes.
- Some of the project's distribution lines, which were going to run underneath high voltage lines, will now be moved and could be buried.

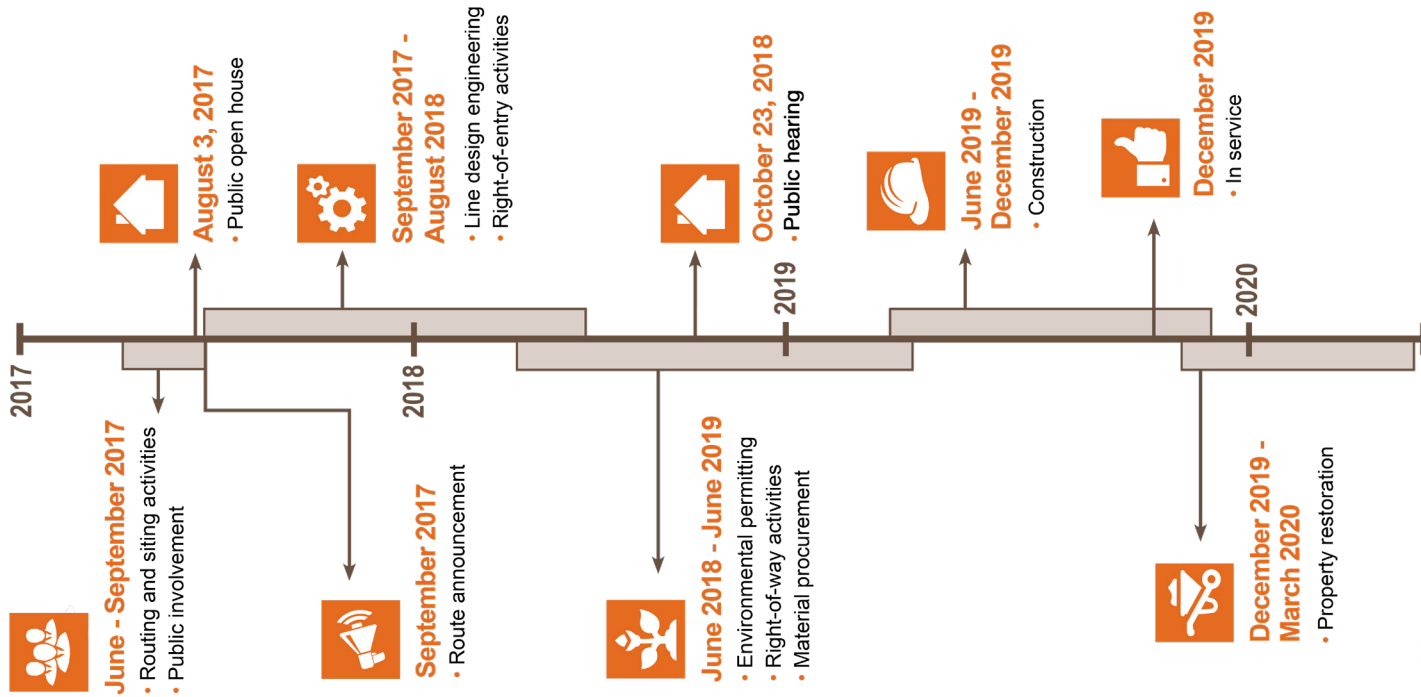
