Community Betterment

Scrap Tire Management Grant Programs

Deadline: July 3 – Aug. 14

Eligibility: Nonprofits and city, county, or municipal government

Description: Assist in financing scrap-tire programs and projects, such as loose crumb rubber for manufacturing or playgrounds, playground or walkway mats, and athletic track surfaces, poured-in-place playground surfaces, artificial football or soccer fields made from crumb rubber.

Litter Reduction & Recycling Grant Program

Deadline: July 3 – Aug. 14

Eligibility: Public and private agencies

Description: Support programs to reduce litter, provide education, and promote recycling in Nebraska.

Waste Reduction & Recycling Incentive Grants

Deadline: July 3 – Aug. 14

Eligibility: Nonprofits and city, county, or municipal government.

Description: Assist in financing sound, integrated waste management programs and projects. These programs and projects include recycling systems, market development for recyclable materials, intermediate processing facilities, facilities using recyclable materials in new products, yard-waste composting and composting with sewage sludge, waste reduction and materials exchange, household hazardous waste programs, consolidation of solid-waste disposal facilities and use of transfer stations and incineration for energy recovery.

Target Public Safety Grants

Deadline: March 1 – Oct. 1

Eligibility: Public agencies or federally tax-exempt 501(c)(3) charitable organizations in the United States

Description: Provides organizations across the country with funds to support crime prevention programs and community safety initiatives.

Deadline: Aug. 8

Eligibility: Local government entities and nonprofit organizations

Description: Projects must integrate arts, culture, and design activities into efforts that strengthen communities by advancing local economic, physical, and/or social outcomes. These projects require a partnership between a local government entity and nonprofit organization, one of which must be a cultural organization.
