March Baseload Generation

- Nebraska City Unit 1 Capacity Factor: 60.4%
- Nebraska City Unit 2 Capacity Factor: 0.5%
- North Omaha Unit 4 Capacity Factor: 46.7%
- North Omaha Unit 5 Capacity Factor: 44.3%



March Peaking Generation

- Cass County Capacity Factor 0.5%
- Jones Street Capacity Factor 0%
- North Omaha Unit 1 Capacity Factor 0%
- North Omaha Unit 2 Capacity Factor 0%
- North Omaha Unit 3 Capacity Factor 0%
- Sarpy County Capacity Factor 1.3%



March Renewables

- Renewable energy contributed 42.7% of OPPD's retail energy sales.
- Wind capacity factor of 47.5%.
- Capacity Factor for Community Solar 17.5%.
- Capacity Factor for Community Solar YTD is 12.8%.

Energy Efficiency Assistance Program (EEAP)

- Re-launch of the former Smart Steps program with simplified application process & updated program guidelines
 - Pilot results: OPPD served 70 homes since the fall of 2019 with average energy savings of \$245 per home
 - Program goal: OPPD will strive to serve 100 new homes in 2021
- Program provides energy efficiency kit and an inhome energy assessment
- Covers up to \$2000 in EE improvement projects to help make an increased impact on utility bills
- New program name and logo, focused on the functionality + benefit of the program
- Updated webpage and program materials
