WHEREAS, the Vice President and Chief Financial Officer is accountable for the annual budget of \$1.71 billion in 2021 Board authorized expenditures, total debt outstanding at September 30, 2021 of \$1.94 billion, and investments at September 30, 2021 of \$1.19 billion; and

- SD-3: Access to Credit Markets
- SD-14: Retirement Plan Funding


FACTS
