- Nebraska City Unit 1 Capacity Factor: 68.4%
- Nebraska City Unit 2 Capacity Factor: 58.7%
- North Omaha Unit 4 Capacity Factor: 37.6%
- North Omaha Unit 5 Capacity Factor: 64.6%



May Balancing Generation

- Cass County Capacity Factor 4.8%
- Jones Street Capacity Factor 0.8%
- North Omaha Unit 1 Capacity Factor 4.8%
- North Omaha Unit 2 Capacity Factor 2.2%
- North Omaha Unit 3 Capacity Factor 5.7%
- Sarpy County Capacity Factor 7.4%



May Renewables
