- Nebraska City Unit 2 Capacity Factor: 88.6%
- North Omaha Unit 4 Capacity Factor: 63%
- North Omaha Unit 5 Capacity Factor: 72.1%



August Balancing Generation

- Cass County Capacity Factor 19.5%
- Jones Street Capacity Factor 0%
- North Omaha Unit 1 Capacity Factor 2%
- North Omaha Unit 2 Capacity Factor .8%
- North Omaha Unit 3 Capacity Factor 9%
- Sarpy County Capacity Factor 12.6%
