### **September Baseload Generation**

- Nebraska City Unit 1 Capacity Factor: 41.8%
- Nebraska City Unit 2 Capacity Factor: 12.9%
- North Omaha Unit 4 Capacity Factor: 51.3%
- North Omaha Unit 5 Capacity Factor: 61.3%



## **September Balancing Generation**

- Cass County Capacity Factor 8.4%
- Jones Street Capacity Factor 0.2%
- North Omaha Unit 1 Capacity Factor 0%
- North Omaha Unit 2 Capacity Factor 0.7%
- North Omaha Unit 3 Capacity Factor 24%
- Sarpy County Capacity Factor 6.5%



### **September Renewables**

- Renewable energy contributed 31.6% of OPPD's retail energy sales
- Wind capacity factor of 40.3%
- Capacity Factor for Community Solar 26.5%
