March 2024 Balancing Generation

- Cass County – Capacity Factor: 1%
- Jones Street – Capacity Factor: 1%
- Sarpy County – Capacity Factor: 8%
- North Omaha Unit 1 – Capacity Factor: 0.0%
- North Omaha Unit 2 – Capacity Factor: 0.0%
- North Omaha Unit 3 – Capacity Factor: 0.0%

March 2024 Renewables

- Renewables – Capacity Factor: 54.0%
- Wind – Capacity Factor: 50.8%
- Community Solar – Capacity Factor: 22.2%
