November Baseload Generation

- Nebraska City Unit 1 – Capacity Factor: 57.3%
- Nebraska City Unit 2 – Capacity Factor: 63.1%
- North Omaha Unit 4 – Capacity Factor: 65.8%
- North Omaha Unit 5 – Capacity Factor: 50.8%

November Balancing Generation

- Cass County – Capacity Factor 3.1%
- Jones Street – Capacity Factor 0%
- North Omaha Unit 1 – Capacity Factor 0%
- North Omaha Unit 2 – Capacity Factor 0%
- North Omaha Unit 3 – Capacity Factor 0%
- Sarpy County – Capacity Factor 1.5%

November Renewables

- Renewable energy contributed 45.8% of OPPD's retail energy sales
- Wind capacity factor of 58.6%
- Capacity Factor for Community Solar 14.3%

Cass County - Gretna 345kV Transmission Project

- Project Highlights
 - 345kV transmission line between OPPD's Cass County Power Station substation and an OPPD substation at 180th and Giles
 - Ensures reliability & resiliency
 - ~29 miles total length
 - Steel monopole construction
 - Distance between steel poles ~800 feet
 - Estimated Completion ~2026

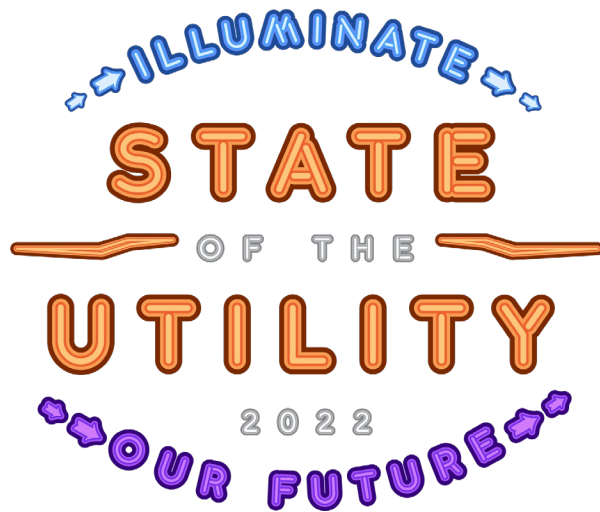
