NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED by the Board of Directors of the Omaha Public Power District that the proposal of Klute Inc. in the amount of \$521,221.85 for the fabrication and delivery of steel structures to support development of a new substation pursuant to Request for Proposal No. 5989 is hereby accepted, and the form of payment and performance bond of such bidder is approved.

Board of Directors authorization to award RFP No. 5989 for the fabrication and delivery of steel structures to support development of a new substation.

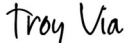
FACTS

1. Development of this substation supports load growth in the Douglas County area.
2. Substation steel structures support bus, disconnect switches and other substation electrical equipment.
3. Five (5) proposals were received of which four (4) were legally responsive and all are technically responsive.
4. Steel structures to be delivered onsite by July 2023.
5. The proposal from Klute Inc. was evaluated as the lowest and best bid.

Analysis of Proposals

1.00 GENERAL

RFP No. 5989 was advertised for bid on November 15, 2022.

This contract will procure steel structures to complete the electrical equipment installation for the new substation project to support load growth and reliability in the Douglas County area.

Material is scheduled to be delivered onsite by July 17, 2023.

No Letters of Clarification were issued.

No Addendums were issued.

Bids were requested and opened at 2:00 p.m., C.S.T., Tuesday, December 13, 2022.

Five total proposals were received. The proposals received are summarized in the table below:

2.00 COMPLIANCE WITH CONTRACT TERMS AND GENERAL REQUIREMENTS

All proposals were deemed to be technically responsive.

4.00 RECOMMENDATION

On the basis of compliance with the legal and technical requirements of the specifications, cost evaluations performed and guaranteed completion dates, it is recommended that RFP No. 5989, "Substation Steel Structures" be awarded to Klute Inc. in the amount of Five Hundred Twenty-One Thousand, Two Hundred Twenty-One Dollars and Eighty-Five Cents (\$521,221.85).

We have reviewed the five (5) proposals received in response to the District's RFP No. 5989 and provide the following legal opinion.

The proposal of Dis-Tran Steel did not include a guaranteed delivery date. This renders the proposal non-responsive to the contract documents. The Dis-Tran Steel proposal cannot receive further consideration by the Board for the award of this RFP.

Subject to the District's technical and economic evaluation, the four (4) proposals other than the Dis-Tran Steel proposal may be considered by the District's Board of Directors for the award of this contract. The form of performance and payment bond for the successful bidder also must be approved by the Board.
